Logistics and Distribution Pathway	Term 3 CO-OP TERM 4	Upgrade your skills and knowledge for employment in the logistics and distribution field. Upgrade your skills and knowledge in inventory management, marketing, transportation and distribution, as well as supply and demand. Add to your certifications and job readiness skills. Learn computer skills required for the workplace. Earn 2 credits towards their high school diploma. Participate in a cooperative education placement that provides job readiness training. 9 weeks in class and 9 weeks Co-op. Get certified in Working @ Heights Training, Forklift Training, CPR/First Aid training, and WHMIS Awareness.
Building Maintenance & Environmental Services Pathway	Term 3 CO-OP TERM 4	Upgrade your skills and knowledge for employment in the building maintenance and environmental services industry: carpenter, framer, drywaller, building superintendent, custodian, landscaping, decks & fences, and groundskeeper. Increase your computer skills, math knowledge, and job readiness, and earn the required certifications. Get certified in WHMIS, First Aid and CPR and Fire Extinguisher Certification. 9 weeks in class and 9 weeks of co-op.
Hospitality Pathway	Term 3 CO-OP TERM 4	Upgrade your skills and knowledge for employment in the hospitality industry - Assistant Cook, Prep Cook, Line Cook, and Catering. You can earn 4 credits towards your diploma. Learn food preparation - safe food handling, kitchen professional skills, customer service. Obtain a professional uniform for food lab and placement. Become job ready for the Cooperative Education placement. Earn certifications in Food handling, WHMIS Awareness training, and First Aid/CPR. 9 weeks in class and 9 weeks of co-op.
Term 4 Dual Credit	(HCC4T1) Psychology and the Law, possibly with HSP3C1 (Introduction Anthropology, Psychology and Sociology)	Program run in conjunction with Durham College. Applicant must apply for the program in term 3. Certain criteria applies for this program. Criteria includes, the applicant must be 21yrs old or older, not have their OSSD, have good attendance, have completed gr 11 English preferably Gr 12 English.
