Upcoming Construction at Dunbarton High School

Dear Parents/Guardians

Our school, Dunbarton High School, is in the fortunate position of being selected by the DDSB to receive renovations and improvements to our Academic Resource and Student Success Rooms.

Work in this area is scheduled to begin over the Winter Holiday Break and is expected to be completed by early Spring 2019.
