Include an annotation of the source

The APA Reference

• Alphabetize your references by the letter in the first entry of your reference (i.e. Author)

- Double spaced
- Use a hanging indent for subsequent lines in the citation

The Annotation

Include the following

- Summary (paraphrased) what topics are covered, what are the main arguments, what are the main points of the source
- Assessment Is the source useful to your purpose (research)?
 Is the information reliable? Is the information biased or objective?
- Reflection How does the source fit into your research? Will the article help you shape your argument? How can you use this information in your research?

Summary
