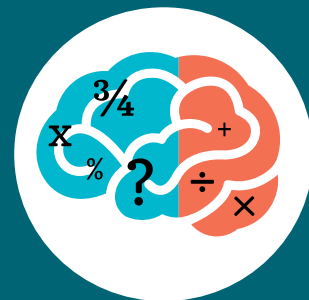

AQ Subsidy 23/24



Embark on a transformative journey in teaching mathematics through Additional Qualification courses.

Enhance your instructional practices, foster thriving pedagogical learning spaces, and humanize the learning environment. Supported by Ministry initiatives, full course cost subsidies* are available for eligible courses, including those offered by the Durham District School Board (DDSB). Elevate your teaching experience and contribute to creating classrooms where every student's humanity and dignity are nurtured. Complete an Additional Qualification course from the list below with any OCT approved provider and make a meaningful impact on your teaching approach.

MATHEMATICS Eligible Courses:

- Primary and Junior Part 1; Part 2; Part 3
- Grades 7 & 8
- Intermediate (ABQ)
- Senior (ABQ)
- Honours Specialist

Total Subsidy Available: Up to a maximum of \$650.00
Course must be completed between **September 1, 2023**
– **August 31, 2024**
Application **Deadline September 15, 2024**

Qualifying courses may be completed through any OCT approved provider. Proof of course payment and course completion is required to be submitted at the time of application. Incomplete applications will not be processed. Verification of course completion to be shown through submission of OCT documentation or Letter of Recommendation issued by AQ provider. Reimbursement will be through direct deposit.

Any DDSB teachers meeting the criteria as outlined above are invited to submit for reimbursement.

NOTE: Subsidy available to system funding totals of approximately 150 teachers accessing approved Math AQ courses and is provided on a first-come, first-served basis. In cases where multiple, qualifying AQ courses have been completed by the same individual, please note, initially we will only be approving one application per person. If we are able to, we will revisit the applications (in the order they were received) and approve as many subsequent reimbursements as we are able to based on available funds. Applicants may only apply for this subsidy if they have not already applied for/received reimbursement for the same course from any other AQ provider or program.
